

Ordinance Number 122

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of Laurel Avenue in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the west line of Cleveland Avenue to the easterly line of a street commonly known as Railroad Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The assessment for the improvement of Laurel Avenue in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the west line of Cleveland Avenue to the easterly line of a street commonly known as Railroad Avenue, is hereby declared and levied according to Assessment Roll Number 12, and the whole cost of said improvement is the sum of of \$5,372.77.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie, in this. It is necessary for that the assessment for the improvement of Laurel Avenue be made in order that funds may immediately raised to pay for the improvement of the same. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall go into force and effect from and af or its approval by the Mayor.
