to hereafter engage in, or carry on the business or occupation of bill-posting, sign and bulletin painting, distributing circulars, advertising matter or samples, or any similar business, or any part thereof in the town of Milwaukie, without first having obtained a license therefor, from the Recorder of the town of Milwaukie, the fee for said license shall be Five (5) Dollars a year, in advance, no license to be issued for less than one year; provided however, that all theatres, churches, fraternal or other organizations, local merchants or citizens shall not be required to obtain such license, unless carrying on such advertising as an occupation or business.

Section 2. No person, firm or corporation except upon property owned and controlled by them, shall tack or cause to be tacked or done by any person, upon any surface or place in the town of Milwaukie, where the same can be seen from any street, alley, or other public place of the town, any cloth banner, card, or sign of any material, advertising circuses, theatrical attractions, liquors, tobacco, or any article of trade or commerce.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five (5) Dollars, nor more than Fifty (50) Dollars.

Section 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety, of the town of Milwaukie, and the enforcement thereof, in this, that it is necessary that persons be prohibited from bill-posting, distributing advertising matter, or samples, sign or bulletin painting, or any similar business, or any part thereof, without first obtaining a license so to do, therefore an emergency is declared and this ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
