

ORDINANCE NO. 127.

An ordinance prohibiting the running at large of chickens, geese, or fowl of any description, within the corporate limits of the town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That no chickens, geese, ducks, or fowl of any description shall be allowed to run at large on, or in, any of the streets, alleys, parks, public places, or in or on any private grounds or premises, or on any such ground or premises owned or controlled by owner, or person in charge of such chickens, geese, ducks, or fowl of any description within the corporate limits of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the owner, or person having control or charge of chickens, geese, ducks, or fowl of any description, who shall permit or allow any of such chickens, geese, ducks, or fowl of any description to act contrary to Section 1 of this ordinance, shall, on conviction,
