

ORDINANCE NO. 133.

... providing for a special city election in and for the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, in the State of Oregon, to the question of amending the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie by adoption or rejection of an act entitled, "A Bill for an act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter, providing for and authorizing said Town of Milwaukie to issue bonds of \$25,000.00 additional water bonus for the purpose of completing the Bull Run Water System and installing water meters for each consumer," and declaring an emergency.

... of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

That a special City election shall be held within the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, in the State of Oregon, on the 10th day of August, 1915, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of the Town of Milwaukie for their adoption or rejection the following entitled act: "A Bill for an act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, in the State of Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter, providing for and authorizing said Town of Milwaukie to issue and dispose of \$25,000.00 additional water bonds for the purpose of completing the Bull Run Water System and installing meters for each consumer.

That such election shall be held and conducted and the votes counted and the returns made in all respects as and required by law and the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie.

Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection of the public health, peace and safety of the Town of Mil-

waukie and the inhabitants thereof in this: It is necessary that an assessment be raised immediately for the purpose of completing the Bull Run Water System under construction in the Town of Milwaukie by laying water laterals and distributing mains, and for the purchase of water meters. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor. Passed the Council this 10th day of August, 1915.
