

ORDINANCE NO. 136.

repealed by ordinance #1016

An Ordinance changing and naming the division line between Wards number one and two in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the division line between ward number one (1) and number two (2) in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, be and the same be by changed as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point where the Portland and Oregon City Railway Company's track crosses the north boundary line of the Town of Milwaukie thence running in a southerly direction following said railroad track to Harrison Street; thence running along Harrison Street in a westerly direction to twenty-eighth (28) Street; thence in a southerly direction following Twenty-eighth (28) Street to Washington; thence running in a southerly direction along the division line between the Sellwood and Neman tracts to the north line of the Olsen tract; thence running in a southeasterly direction following the north line of the Olsen tract to the division line between the Olsen and Hoesley tracts; thence running in a southerly direction following the division line between the Olsen and Hoesley tracts to Lake Road; thence in a southeasterly direction following said Lake Road to the Oatfield Road; thence Southerly along Oatfield Road to City limits.

Section 2. That all ordinances and parts of ordinance in conflict with is hereby repealed.
