

ORDINANCE NO. 137.

An ordinance authorizing the issue and prescribing the form of the
Water bonds of the Town of Milwaukie and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The \$25,000 water bonds authorized by an amendment to
Charter adopted by the people on the 21st day of August, 1915, which
was sold to the Western Bond & Mortgage Co., on the 14th day of September
