

An Ordinance prescribing the rules and regulations for the conduct and management of the Water System of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Applications for the use of water must be made on print signed by the owner, lessee or agent, to be furnished by the Water Superintendent and the applicant must state fully and truly all the purposes for which water may be required, and must agree to conform to the Rules and Regulations, as a condition for the use of water.

Section 2. No user supplied with water from the City mains will be allowed to use it for any other purpose than stated in his application, nor supply in any way other persons or families. Should any user wish to use the water for a purpose not stated in his original application, a new application must be made to the Water Superintendent.

Section 3. Whenever an application has been accepted by the Water Superintendent, he shall with reasonable diligence make the connection for water, in the manner hereinafter set forth. He shall open a trench for the service pipes, from within the curb line, if such has been established, or from near the property line, to the main in the street; the service pipes must not be less than two feet below the grade of the street, and must be laid at right angles to the main; must be properly connected to the main at a corporation cock (with saddle when necessary) of not less than 5-8 inch standard size and a lead flange connection. All service pipes and fittings to be of galvanized iron and to be not less than 3-4 inch in diameter. Twelve inches inside of the street curb, a flat headed round water cock shall be placed and the meter connected thereto, both being protected by a suitable box. In case of a service connection where these regulations can not be made to apply, the Water Superintendent may vary these regulations and regulations upon having received the approval of the Water Commission of the Council.

Section 4. ^{Amended by Ord 435 Repealed by Ord 554} ^{Amended - Ord 554} All connections shall be made by the Water Department and at cost of labor, material and hauling, except a standard 5-8 inch meter for which no charge shall be made to users within the corporate boundaries. Such costs to be computed from the center line of the street and must be paid within six months after installation, and if not paid the same shall become a lien against the premises served and collected in like manner as delinquent street improvement liens. The Town of Milwaukie shall have sole jurisdiction over all service connections, and it shall be unlawful for any person to interfere therewith.

Section 5. Service pipes must be of galvanized iron, and the lead connections must be of a quality and weight corresponding to the A. gauge, and the galvanized corresponding to the A. A. gauge, and the galvanized pipes of a corresponding strength. The lead service from the galvanized iron service must be:

The private service pipes, within and without the premises,
 about their entire length from the connection with the meter,
 kept in repair and protected from freezing or waster. Where
 a leak and it is doubtful whether the water comes from a
 the city service, or from a private service pipe, the Water
 shall make an excavation to determine which it is from. If
 is found to be from the city service, the Water Department will
 repairs, free of charge; but if it is from the private service
 notice of such leakage will be left on the premises and the own-
 or agent must immediately repair the leak and be responsible
 damages which may result.

Should the user desire to discontinue the use of all water
 to the premises for a period of not less than 30 days, notice
 must be given to the Water Superintendent, and payment in full
 years (if any there be), made at the City Treasurer's Office.
 will then be turned off, and turned on again on application,
 charge; but no remission of rates will be made for a period of
 30 days, or without the notcie prescribed in this section.

The service pipes must be so arranged that the supply to
 rate house or premises may be controlled by a meter, and one
 pay for all the water used through said service for his own
 or the use of others to whom it may be accessable.

Water will not be furnished where there are defective or
 faucets, closets or other fixtures, or where there are water
 or urinals without self-closing valves, or tanks without self-
 hat valves; and when such may be discovered, the supply will
 ff. Water must not be allowed to run to waste through any
 fixtures in order to prevent freezing, or kept running at
 longer than necessary in its proper use. When such waster is
 exist, the water will be shut off from the premises.

No plumber or other person will be allowed to make connect-
 the city mains, or to make alterations in any conduit, pipe
 fixtures connecting therewith, or to connect pipes when they
 disconnected, or to turn water off or on any premises, with-
 sion of the Superintendent of the Water Department.

The water may at any time be shut off from the mains, with-
 e, for repairs or other necessary purposes, and the Water De-
 will not be responsible for any consequent damages. Water for
 lers for power purposes will not be furnished by direct pres-
 the city mains; tanks for holding an ample reserve supply of
 ill always be provided by the owners of the boilers. While
 temporarily shut off from the mains, the hot water faucets
 kept open by the occupants of the premises, to allow the steam
 from the water heaters, and should damage result to the meter
 of steam or hot water, the owner shall be charged for repairs.

Employees of the Water Department shall have free access at
