

ORDINANCE NO. 144.

An Ordinance establishing the grades on 27th Street from the south  
Washington Street to the end, 1000 ft. distant woutherly from the  
Washington Street.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the grades of the center line of 27th Street be  
hereby established at the following elevations:

- At the south line of Washington Street. . . . .
- Thence on a concave vertical curve 100 feet long with a middle or  
dinate of 0.82.
- At a point 100 feet south of the south line of Washington Street
- At a point 250 feet south of the south line of Washington St. . . . .
- Thence on a convex vertical curve 100 feet long with a middle or  
dinate of 0.88.
- At a point 350 feet south of the south line of Washington St. . . . .
- At a point 700 feet south of the south line of Washington St. . . . .
- Thence on a convex vertical curve 100 feet long with a middle or  
dinate of 0.22.
- At a point 800 feet south of the south line of Washington St. . . . .
- At a point 1000 feet south of the south line of Washington St. . . . .

Section 2. Reference is hereby had to the official City datum re  
ed by bench-mark at the northeast corner of the City Hall with a
