

ORDINANCE NO. 147

... providing for the improvement of 27th Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the south line of Washington Street to a point about 1000 feet south of the south line of Washington Street, and in emergency.

Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 147. (Cont'd)

Section 1. Twenty-seventh Street in Milwaukie, Oregon, shall be improved from the south line of Washington Street to a point about 1000 feet south of the south line of Washington Street in conformity with the specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, and which were adopted by resolution of the Town Council on the 15th day of October, 1916.

Section 2. Parties bidding on the work provided herein must state in their bid the time required for the completion of the entire improvement herein specified, and should the contractor fail to complete the work within the times specified in the contract, the Town shall have the right to charge the contractor the sum of \$25.00 per day as liquidated damages for each and every day that the work shall remain uncompleted after the date, and said sum shall be deducted from the amount of the final payment. No proposal shall be considered when not accompanied by a certified check of 5% of the total estimate, drawn to the order of the Town of Milwaukie, which check shall be forfeited to the Town in the event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the agreement provided herein, within ten days after the award of the contract.

Section 3. Blank forms upon which all proposals are submitted shall be furnished upon application to the City Engineer. Upon the acceptance of said improvement and after the assessment therefore is made and levied, the Mayor and Recorder shall draw warrants on the fund created for said improvement, and in favor of the parties entitled thereto.

Section 4. The Contractor will be required to furnish bonds with approved security in the sum of \$2000.00, considered upon the faith of the performance of the work in accordance with all the stipulations of the contract, within the time named therein.

Section 5. Whenever the word "Engineer" is named in said specifications it is understood to refer to the City Engineer, employed and authorized by the Council to superintend such work.

Section 6. Whenever the Word "Contractor" occurs in said specifications, it is understood to refer to the Contractor or firm, or to any Contractors or any member thereof, or any contractor undertaking the work herein specified. All the work and material furnished shall be done and furnished to the satisfaction of the City Engineer. The Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

Section 7. Each contract shall contain a stipulation to the effect that the person, firm or corporation to whom the said contract is awarded shall look for the payment to the sum assessed upon the property to pay for such improvement, and collected and paid into the Town Treasury, for that purpose, and that they will not require the Town of Milwaukie, by any legal process or otherwise, to pay the said sum out of any other fund.

Section 8. Whereas the condition of said street is and was dangerous to the health and safety of the public, and its immediate improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, therefore an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval by the Mayor.

All ordinances heretofore enacted by the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed... 6. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than \$100.00, or imprisoned in jail for not more than 30 days, or both, at the discretion of the Council... 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval by the Mayor... 8. Attest: Mayor. ATT
