

An Ordinance granting Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to repair, renew and make such improvements on its trestle across Kellogg Lake in the Town of Milwaukie as may be found necessary.

WHEREAS by the terms of a certain agreement entered between the Town of Milwaukie, a municipal corporation, and Beaver Willsburg Railroad Company, a corporation, recorder in Book 109 of Clackamas County, at Page 71, it is provided that said railroad company shall fill Kellogg Lake from Webster Road to Foster Road along the line of the track of said railroad company whenever in the operation of said railroad the proposed trestle requires replacing, and,

WHEREAS, it is now deemed advisable to conserve and economize expenditure of labor and material which would be required to be expended in the making of such fill, and,

WHEREAS Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, is the successor in interest to the rights of said Beaverton & Willsburg Railroad Company in and to said line of railroad, now therefore,

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, is hereby granted the right and privilege to repair, renew and make such improvements on the trestle across Kellogg Lake in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon
