

An ordinance requiring all gasoline, or other inflammable volatile in quantities over five gallons, to be kept only in tanks buried at least four feet under ground; regulating the storage of gunpowder, dynamite, giant powder, nitroglycerine or any other explosives whatsoe-

The Town of Milwaukie ordains as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep or store any gasoline, or other inflammable volatile in quantities over five gallons in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, in non-rusting metal tanks of not more than 300 gallons capacity and said tanks shall be placed outside of the building and at least four feet underground.

ORDINANCE NO. 163. (Cont'd)

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to store any gunpowder, dynamite, giant powder, nitro-glycerine, or explosives whatsoever, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, without having obtained a permit to do so from the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon. Whenever any person, firm or corporation shall file an application for a permit to keep or store the above mentioned explosives within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, it shall be the duty of the council and Fire Chief and Fire Chief shall find the place to be a suitable and safe place for keeping or storing said explosives the Council may grant said permit and issue a permit, but if for any reason they shall deem it to be in the best interest of the Town they shall refuse to grant such

That Ordinance No. 1 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not over \$200.00, or by imprisonment in the Town or County jail for a period of not exceeding sixty
