

ORDINANCE NO. 165.

... providing for the improvement of 24th Street, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the north line of a sixteen foot pavement to Harrison Street thence northerly along the center line of 24th Street for an approximate distance of 557 feet, and declaring that the same is in the public interest. The Council of the Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That 24th Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, be improved from the north line of a sixteen foot pavement to be located at Harrison Street to a point approximately five hundred fifty-seven feet northerly therefrom in conformity to and in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and which were approved and adopted by Resolution of the Town Council on the 1st day of June, 1920.

Section 2. Whereas the said 24th Street is in a dangerous condition and its improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the approval by the Mayor.
