fifty-seven... ordinance establishing the grades on 32nd Street, in the Town of Oregon, from the south line of Elmer Street to the North line of Madison Street, and repealing ordinance number 141.

order of the Council of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

That the grades on 32nd Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Ore., hereby are established at the following elevations:

Intersection of the center line of 32nd Street with the south line of Elmer Street. 158.00

Point on the center line of 32nd Street, said point being north of the north line of Madison Street. 156.98

A concave vertical curve with a length of 50 feet and a vertical curve ordinate of 0.15 feet.

Point on the center line of 32nd Street, said point being north of the north line of Madison Street. 156.63

Intersection of the center line of 32nd Street with the south line of Madison Street. 157.50

Intersection of the center line of 32nd Street with the north line of Madison Street. 157.50

Point on the center line of 32nd Street, said point being south of the south line of Madison Street. 158.70

A concave vertical curve 225 feet long with a middle ordinate of 2.64 feet.

Point on the center line of 32nd Street, said point being south of the south line of Madison Street. 170.63

Intersection of the center line of 32nd Street with the north line of Sellwood Street. 193.13

Intersection of the center line of 32nd Street with the south line of Sellwood Street. 195.45

Point on the center line of 32nd Street, said point being south of the south line of Sellwood Street. 200.95

A convex vertical curve 50 feet long with a middle ordinate of 0.66 feet.

Point on the center line of 32nd Street, said point being south of the south line of Sellwood Street. 203.80

Intersection of the center line of 32nd Street with the north line of Wister Street. 205.40

Reference is hereby had to the official City datum represented by a benchmark at the northeast corner of the City Hall with an elevation of 100.00 feet.

Ordinance number 141 is hereby repealed.
