

ORDINANCE NO. 170.

An ordinance providing for the improvement of 32nd Street, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the south line of Elmer Street to the north line of Wister Street, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That 32nd Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the south line of Elmer Street to the north line of Wister Street, be improved in conformity to and in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, which were approved and adopted by Resolution of the Town Council on the 15th day of July, 1920.

Section 2. Whereas the said 32nd Street is in a dangerous condition and its improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof; therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the approval by the Mayor.
