

ORDINANCE NO. 172.

*repealed by ordinance #1016*

prohibiting the picketing or staking out of live stock in, in any manner as a pasture for live stock, of the streets, public highways in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon; repealing ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions hereof.

of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, to stake out live stock in, or use in any manner whatsoever for live stock, any street, alley or public highway in the Milwaukie, Oregon.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Any person, firm or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than \$100.00, or imprisoned in the city jail for a period not exceeding 30 days.
