For the purpose of this ordinance every place where pool or are played where a charge is made, either directly or indirect- refer, or any thing of value given therefor, shall be regarded as a public pool or billiard room or rooms.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to engage in the business or occupation of conducting a public pool or billiard room or rooms within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, where pool or billiards are played, without first obtaining a license therefor. Any person, firm or corporation desiring to conduct or operate a public pool or billiard room or rooms where pool or billiards are played, within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, shall pay to the Treasurer of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, a license fee of \$10.00 per quarter, where only one table is used, payable on the first day of each quarter, namely; the first day of January; the first day of April; the first day of July, and the first day of October of each year, but where the applicant desires to use more than one table he shall pay an additional \$2.50 for each additional table used, payable on the first day of each quarter.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any proprietor, keeper, owner or person in charge of any public pool or billiard room or rooms within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, to permit, suffer or allow any minor to go into, visit, be or remain in any public pool or billiard room or rooms.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any minor to go into, visit or remain in or about any public pool or billiard room or rooms within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 5. Every public pool or billiard room or rooms in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, shall be closed between the hours of 11:30 P.M. of each day and remain closed until the hour of 6:00 A.M. of the next day.

Section 6. It shall be unlawful for any proprietor, keeper, owner or persons in charge of any public pool or billiard room or rooms within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, to permit or allow any game to be played with cards, dice, pool or billiards, for money, checks, credits or any other representation of value, within such pool or billiard room or rooms.

Section 7. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 and costs of prosecution nor more than \$100.00 and costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days, and upon a second conviction his license shall be revoked.

Section 8. That ordinance No. 159 and all other ordinances and resolutions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
