

ORDINANCE NO. 174.

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of 32nd Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the South line of Elmer Street to the North line of Wister Street, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The assessment for the improvement of 32nd Street, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the South line of Elmer Street to the North line of Wister Street is hereby declared and levied according to assessment Roll No. 14, the whole cost of which assessment is hereby declared to be the sum of \$2258.53.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, in this: It is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public that funds be levied to pay for the improvement of 32nd Street. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
