

An ordinance providing for the improvement of Harvey Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from a point beginning on the east side of County Road No. 162, and about 593 feet southerly from the northwest corner of the Hector Campbell D. L. C. Cl. No. 69, thence easterly to the limits of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 177.

That Harvey Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, shall be improved from a point beginning on the east side of County Road No. 162, and about 593 feet southerly from the northwest corner of the Hector Campbell D. L. C. Claim No. 69, thence easterly to the City limits of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, in conformity to and in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and which were adopted by resolution of the Town Council on the 4th day of October, 1921.

Whereas the said street is in a dangerous condition and improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist,

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
