

An ordinance prohibiting the dumping of garbage, rubbish or other material on any public or private ground within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:-

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to dump or cause to be dumped and garbage, rubbish or other refuse whatsoever on any public or private ground within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, without first having obtained from the Marshal of Milwaukie a permit to do so; provided, however, if the Marshal shall for any reason deem it against the best interest of the Town of Milwaukie to grant

shall refuse to do so.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than \$200.00, or imprisoned in the City Jail for a period not exceeding 60 days.

Any person giving information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be entitled to one-half of the fine imposed at the discretion of the Recorder.
