Said grantee, its successors, lessees and assigns is hereby
... right to make the necessary excavation for the construction
... industry spur track, provided, however, that it shall as prompt-
... able replace said portion of said street in good condition for

vehicular travel, and provided, further than in the event of the
surfacing of the adjacent portion of said street it shall improve
of said industrial spur track with planking or rock screenings
the rails and for eighteen inches outside thereof, such surfacing
level with the tops of rail of said industry spur track and said
shall also bear the cost of the construction of a concrete heading
the purpose of protecting the edge of said hard surfacing as may
stalled.

Section 3. The construction of said industry spur track by said
its successors, lessees or assigns shall be deemed an acceptance
franchise hereby granted, subject to all the terms and conditions
this ordinance set forth.
