of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

1: That Harrison Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, be improved from a point twelve feet west of the east line of 34th Street, thence easterly to the east boundary line of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, in conformity to and in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and which were adopted by Resolution of the Town Council on the 10th day of February, 1923.

Whereas the said Street is in a dangerous condition, and its improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie,

therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
