

ORDINANCE N.O. 194.

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of Myrtle Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the west line of Campbell Street, thence westerly to a point 18 feet east of the center line of Elmer Street, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The assessment for the improvement of Myrtle Street, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the west line of Campbell Street thence westerly to a point 18 feet east of the center line of Elmer Street, is hereby declared and levied according to assessment Roll Numbered Fifteen (15), the whole cost of which improvement is \$21,000.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assessment for the improvement of Myrtle Street be made in order to secure funds for the payment of the same.

Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
