That 23rd Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, shall be improved from the south line of Washington Street, thence southerly to the north line of Young's Addition in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, in accordance with the plans and specifications filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, by resolution of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 12th day of June, 1923.

Whereas the said street is in a dangerous condition, and it is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Mayor.
