improvement is the sum of \$2965.76.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that an assessment for the improvement of Harrison Street be made in order to raise funds for the payment of the same.

Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
