

ORDINANCE NO. 201.

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of 31st Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from a point 18 feet south of the center line of Elmer Street, thence southerly to the terminus of 31st Street, an approximate distance of 1685 feet, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement of 31st Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from a point 18 feet south of the line of Elmer Street, thence southerly to the terminus of said Street, an approximate distance of 1685 feet, is hereby declared levied according to Assessment Roll Numbered Seventeen (17), the cost of which improvement is \$3071.60.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assessment for the improvement of said street be immediately levied in order to secure funds for the payment of the cost of the improvement thereof.

Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
