

ORDINANCE NUMBER 205.

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of 29th. Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from Washington Street to Harrison Street, and declaring an emergency.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement of 29th. Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from Washington Street to Harrison Street, in said Town, is hereby declared and levied according to Assessment Roll Number Eighteen (18), the whole cost of which improvement is \$3215.69.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assessment for the improvement of said Street be immediately made in order to secure funds for the payment of the cost of the improvement thereof. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
