

ORDINANCE NUMBER 206.

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of 23rd. Street, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the south line of Washington Street, thence southerly to the north line of Young's Addition, and declaring an emergency.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement of 23rd. Street, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the southerly line of Washington Street, thence southerly to the north line of Young's Addition, is hereby declared and levied according to Assessment Roll Number Nineteen (19), the whole cost of which improvement is the sum of \$1174.20.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitant thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assessment for the improvement of said street be immediately made in order to secure funds for the payment of the cost of the improvement thereof. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
