

ORDINANCE NO. 216

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE AND EXPLODING OF FIRECRACKERS AND FIREWORKS WITHIN THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation, their agents or employees, to sell, offer to sell, give away or in any manner dispose of to another, any firecracker or fireworks of any kind whatsoever within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to fire, explode, or discharge in any manner whatsoever, any firecracker, firecrackers, or fireworks of any kind whatsoever within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 3. Any person, persons, firm or corporation, their agent or employee who violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined not less than Five Dollars nor more than Two Hundred Dollars.

All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this: That it is necessary to prohibit the discharging, exploding and firing of firecrackers and fireworks within said Town in order to prevent the destruction of property and life by fire. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
