

An ordinance providing for the improvement of 28th Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the south property line of Harrison Street to the north property line of Washington Street, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 232.
(Cont'd)

That 28th Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, shall be improved from the south property line of Harrison Street to the north property line of Washington Street. Said street to be improved in accordance with the plans and specifications for said improvement on file with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, as adopted by a resolution of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 11th day of August, 1925.

Whereas, 28th Street from the south property line of Harrison Street to the north property line of Washington Street is in such a condition that its improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 15th day of September, 1925.
