

ORDINANCE NO. 235.

An ordinance providing building regulations in the Business District of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and providing a penalty for violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That portion of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, lying between Scott Street and Lake Road and between the west line of Scott Street and the Willamette River shall be known as the Business District of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the exterior of all buildings hereafter erected in the Business District of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, shall be constructed of solid concrete, tile, brick or stone. No wooden building structure shall be erected or constructed in the Business District of said Town.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of the ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed sixty days.

Each day that a violation of this ordinance continues shall be considered a separate offense.
