Section 1. That the portion of Jefferson Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, lying between Main and Front Streets shall be improved according to the plans and specifications therefor heretofore on file with the Recorder and adopted by a resolution of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 10th day of August, 1926.

Section 2. Whereas, that portion of Jefferson Street lying between Main and Front Streets is in such a condition that its improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
