

ORDINANCE NO. 250.

An ordinance providing for the construction of a sewer along following lines and routes, to-wit: beginning at the present manhole located in the intersection of 21st and Madison Streets, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon; thence easterly along Madison Street 150 feet; thence southerly along the southerly portion of Lots 1 to 5 inclusive, Block 2 Duersts Addition, and the southerly side of Block 3 Duersts Addition, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a sewer shall be laid and constructed in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, along the following lines and routes, to-wit: Beginning at the present manhole located in the intersection of 21st and Madison Streets, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon; thence easterly along Madison Street 150 feet; thence southerly along the southerly portion of Lots 1 to 5 inclusive, Block 2 Duersts Addition, and the southerly side of Block 3 Duersts Addition. Said sewer shall be constructed in conformity to and in strict accordance with the specifications therefor, heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, which plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part of this ordinance.

Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection of the public health, peace and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, in this: That the construction of the sewer herein provided for is urgently needed and it is necessary to take advantage of weather conditions existing at the present time for the construction thereof. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval by the Mayor. Approved by the Council this 14th day of September, 1926.
