

ORDINANCE NO. 260.

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of 24th Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the north line of Harrison Street northerly to the city limits, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement of 24th Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the north line of Harrison Street northerly to the city limits, is hereby declared and levied according to Assessment Roll Number Twenty-eight (28), the cost of which improvement is the sum of \$566.69.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, and health of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of 24th Street from the north line of Harrison Street northerly to the city limits be immediately made in order to secure funds to pay the cost of improvement thereof. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
