

An ordinance regulating the driving and operating of vehicles in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon; providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith,

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of this ordinance a vehicle shall mean every mechanical device moving by any other power than human power over the streets and highways of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, excepting street and interurban cars.

Section 2. No vehicle shall be driven into any intersection below, from the east, nor into any other intersection, from any direction, where a stop sign has been erected, without first being brought to a full and complete stop:

- Scott Street and Milwaukie Highway; Harrison Street and Milwaukie Highway; Jackson Street and Milwaukie Highway; Washington Street and Milwaukie Highway; Jefferson Street and Milwaukie Highway and Washington Street and Milwaukie Highway, Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 3. No driver shall reverse his direction except at intersections, and in reversing, the vehicle shall be driven along and about the center of the intersection.

Section 4. No person shall operate any motor vehicle within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, with more than two persons in the front seat in addition to the driver; provided, however, that this section shall not apply to any motor bus; and no person operating a motor vehicle shall carry more than one person upon it other than the driver unless the same is equipped with a side car.

1926. 265. No double parking of vehicles shall be permitted in the  
city of Milwaukie, Oregon, and no vehicle shall be parked on that  
land lying between the curb line and the property line ad-  
jacent thereto.

1927. 266. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict here-  
under hereby repealed.

1927. 267. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of  
Ordinance No. 265 shall, upon the conviction thereof, be punished by  
a fine of not more than \$200.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail  
for a period not exceeding 60 days, or both such fine and imprisonment.
