

in this ordinance declaring the assessment for the construction of the Madison Street Sewer in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and declaring an ordinance of the Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

That the assessment for the construction of the Madison Street Sewer in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby declared according to Assessment Roll Number Thirty-two (32), now on file with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

That the whole cost of the construction of the Madison Street Sewer is the sum of Seven Hundred eight and 36/100 Dollars

Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the construction of the Madison Street Sewer be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit. Therefore an ordinance is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect from and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
