

ORDINANCE NUMBER 275.

An ordinance providing for the improvement of 30th. Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from Washington Street southerly to the end of 30th. Street, and declaring an emergency.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That 30th. Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, shall be improved from Washington Street southerly to the end of 30th. Street. Said street to be improved in accordance with the plans and specifications for said improvement heretofore filed with the Recorder and adopted by a resolution of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 9th. day of August, 1927.

Section 2. Whereas, 30th. Street from the Washington Street south to the end of 30th. Street is in such a condition that its immediate improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
