

An ordinance providing for the construction of a sewer in 31st Street in Milwaukie, Oregon, from the present constructed manhole at the intersection of 31st and Elmer Streets, thence southerly along said street a distance of 1600 feet, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a sewer shall be constructed in and along 31st Street in Milwaukie, Oregon, from the present constructed manhole at the intersection of 31st Street 1600 feet. Said sewer to be constructed according to the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, and adopted by a resolution of the Council of Milwaukie on the 23rd day of August, 1927. The said plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the citizens of Milwaukie, Oregon, in this: That the sanitary conditions of said street are bad and the construction of the sewer hereinafter provided for is urgently needed. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
