Street, is hereby declared and levied according to Assessment
Numbered Thirty-four (34), now on file with the Recorder of
Milwaukie, Oregon.

2: That the whole cost of the improvement of 30th Street
amount of Three Hundred Forty-four and 68/100 Dollars (\$344.68).

3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate
restoration of the public peace, health and safety of Milwaukie and
its inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assess-

ment to pay the cost of the improvement of 30th Street be declared
an emergency in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and main-
tain the public credit. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared
and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force
and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
