

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the construction of the 31st Street Sewer, in Milwaukie, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the assessment for the construction of the 31st Street Sewer, in Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby declared and levied according to Assessment Roll numbered Thirty-six (36), now on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the whole cost of the construction of 31st Street Sewer is the sum of Two Thousand Nine hundred sixteen and 98/100 Dollars (\$2916.98).

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the construction of the 31st Street Sewer be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
