

ORDINANCE NO. 287.

An ordinance providing for the improvement of Washington Street in Milwaukie, Oregon, from Railroad Avenue Easterly to the City limits and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Washington Street in Milwaukie, Oregon, be improved from Railroad Avenue easterly to the City limits, and the street to be improved in accordance with the plans and specifications for said improvement heretofore filed with the Recorder and approved by a resolution of the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 15th day of April, 1928.

Section 2. Inasmuch as said street is in such a condition that improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the public: Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall have full force and effect from and after its approval by the Council. Passed the Council this 8th day of May, 1928.
