

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of Washington Street, in Milwaukie, Oregon, from Railroad Avenue to the City limits.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement of Washington Street, in Milwaukie, Oregon, from Railroad Avenue easterly to the City limits, is hereby declared and levied according to Assessment Roll numbered thirty-seven (37), now on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the whole cost of the improvement of Washington Street from Railroad Avenue easterly to the City limits is the sum of one Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-four and 62/100 Dollars.

of Washington Street, in Milwaukie, Oregon and its inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said Washington Street, in Milwaukie, Oregon, from Railroad Avenue easterly to the City limits, be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost of the improvement of said Washington Street, in Milwaukie, Oregon, and to preserve and maintain the public credit. Therefore an emergency ordinance is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its approval by the Council this 10th day of September, 1928.
