

An ordinance establishing the grades of Jefferson Street from the East side of 37th Street east to the City limits, and declaring an emergency.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the grades of Jefferson Street from the East side of 37th Street east to the city limits, be and hereby are declared at the following elevations:

...ing at Station 0 plus 00 which is the intersection of the center line of Block 70 and 71 Minthorn Addition with the center line of Jefferson Street at an elevation of 180.5 feet; thence following the center line of Jefferson Street on a plus grade to Station 3 plus 00 to an elevation of 197.00 feet; thence on a plus 7.2% grade to Station 4 plus 00 to an elevation of 216.33 feet; thence on a plus 8.0% grade to Station 5 plus 51.67 to an elevation of 216.33 feet; thence on a 0.0% grade to Station 5 plus 67 to an elevation of 216.33 feet; thence on a plus 6.7604% grade to Station 8 plus 00 to an elevation of 231.09 feet; thence on a plus 2.1% grade to Station 10 plus 50 to an elevation of 236.34 feet; thence on a plus 3.8% grade to Station 11 plus 61.17 to an elevation of 240.56 feet, said last named station being the intersection of the center line of Jefferson Street with the Easterly city limits of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

2. Reference is hereby had to the official city datum represented by the bench mark at the northeast corner of the City Hall, at an elevation of 100 feet.

3. Inasmuch as said street is in such a condition that its preservation is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the public, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force

from and after its approval by the Mayor.
