

ORDINANCE NUMBER 209.

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the improvement of Jefferson Street in Milwaukie, Oregon, from the east line of 37th. Street easterly to the city limits, and declaring an emergency.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement of Jefferson Street from the east side of 37th. Street easterly to the city limits is hereby declared and levied according to Assessment Roll numbered thirty-nine (39), now on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the whole cost of said improvement is the sum of Thirteen Hundred sixty-nine and 20/100 Dollars (\$1369.20.).

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said street be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
