

## O R D I N A N C E N O. 301.

n emergency ordinance declaring the assessment for the construction of the  
 effect and Myrtle Street Sewer in Milwaukie, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.  
 the Mayor of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

1. That the assessment to pay the cost of the construction  
 Myrtle Street Sewer in Myrtle Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, from  
 present manhole at the intersection of Elmer and Myrtle Streets  
 westerly to a point in Myrtle Street five feet northeasterly of  
 southwesterly corner of Lot 30, Block 2, Robert's Re-plat of J.R.

Wood's Addition to Milwaukie, is hereby declared and levied  
 ment of Assessment Roll numbered Forty-one (41), now on file  
 t 3, Block 2, Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

2. That the whole cost of said improvement is the sum of  
 One Hundred Fifty-two and 56/100 Dollars (\$1452.56).

3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate  
 f Willamette, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is neces-  
 sary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of  
 Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this: It is neces-  
 sary that said assessment be levied in order to pay the cost of the  
 construction of said sewer and maintain the public credit.

Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance  
 shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after  
 its approval by the Mayor.
