

ORDINANCE NUMBER 304.

An ordinance authorizing the issuance of improvement bonds pursuant to the provisions of the Charter of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the amendments thereto, and declaring an emergency.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in pursuant to the applications of the owners of real property to pay the assessment for the construction of the Myrtle Street Sewer in Milwaukie, Oregon, as provided by the provisions of the Charter of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the amendments thereto, the Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to execute improvement bonds of Milwaukie, Oregon, and deliver the same to the Treasurer thereof, who shall deliver said bonds to the purchaser thereof, upon payment of the purchase price. Said bonds shall not be sold for less than par and accrued interest, and shall not exceed the sum of FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR AND 88/100 DOLLARS (\$534.88) in the aggregate. Said bonds are to be issued to pay a portion of the cost of the construction of the Myrtle Street Sewer in Milwaukie, Oregon. The denomination of said bonds shall be as follows: One for Five Hundred Dollars and one for Thirty-four and 88/100 Dollars, and shall be dated the 14th. day of January, 1930, and shall mature ten years from the date thereof, and be paid in Gold Coin of the United States of America, and shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually. Interest to be evidenced by coupons attached to said bonds; provided, however, the right to take up and cancel said bonds upon the payment of the face thereof with accrued interest to date of payment at any semi-annual interest paying period, at or after one year from date of said bonds, is hereby reserved to Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. The Treasurer of Milwaukie is hereby directed to credit, upon receiving the purchase price of said bonds, the face thereof and accrued interest to the Myrtle Street Sewer Fund, and all premiums to the General Fund of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of Milwaukie, Oregon, in this: It is necessary that funds be immediately raised to pay the cost of the Myrtle Street Sewer and maintain the public credit. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
