

ORDINANCE NUMBER 308.

An ordinance establishing official bench marks in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the official bench marks in the Town of Milwaukie be and hereby are established at the following elevations and locations, to-wit:

One in back parking strip in front of City Hall at 21st. and Monroe Streets, at an elevation of 103.60 feet, the same being a 3 inch round top brass casting set in 12" X 12" cement concrete pier with 103.60 feet elevation stamped on the top thereof.

One set in curb in round corner at Northeast corner of intersection of 22nd and Willard Streets, at an elevation 129.62 feet, the same being a 3 inch round top brass casting with 129.62 feet elevation stamped on the top thereof.

One set in curb in round corner at the Southeast corner of intersection of Oak and Elmer Streets, at an elevation of 158.06 feet, the same being a 3 inch round top brass casting with 158.06 feet elevation stamped on the top thereof.

One set in a 12" X 12" cement concrete pier in parking strip 120 feet west of 40th. Street on South side of Harrison Street and in front of entrance to house No. 3916 Harrison Street, at an elevation of 237.40 feet, the same being a 3 inch round top brass casting with 237.40 feet elevation stamped on the top thereof.

One set in the top of the Milwaukie Stand pipe in the Southwest corner thereof at 40th. and Harvey Streets, at an elevation of 252.20 feet, the same being a 3 inch round top brass casting with 252.20 feet elevation stamped on the top thereof.

One set in curb in round corner at the Southwest corner of the intersection of 31st. and Harrison Streets, at an elevation of 162.05 feet, the same being a 3 inch round top brass casting with 162.05 feet elevation stamped on the top thereof.
