of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to operate,
to be operated, any machine, device, apparatus or instrument
and whatsoever, the operation of which shall cause electrical
interference with radio reception within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon,
the hours of 6 o'clock P.M. and 12 o'clock P.M.; provided,

provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to the taking of
pictures, the making of X-ray examinations or the giving of X-ray
examinations; provided further, that said X-ray machine, or apparatus used
therein is properly equipped so as to avoid all unnecessary inter-
ference with radio reception and is not negligently operated.

2. No provisions of this ordinance shall be construed to
cover the regulation of any transmitting, broadcasting or
receiving instrument, apparatus or device used or useful in interstate
commerce or the operation of which instrument, apparatus or device is
not authorized by, or is under the provisions of any act of

the congress of the United States of America, nor to any person, firm, or corporation whose business is regulated by the public service commission of the State of Oregon or its successor regulatory agency. That Section 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
