Section 2. That the said Pacific Garbage Removal Company shall, each month, during the life of this franchise, on a date appointed by this Council, collect all tin cans, glass, bottles, and debris of a similar nature (except garbage, dead animals, and large objects like automobile bodies, wagons and articles of a similar size and/or nature) placed on streets by the citizens of Milwaukee. The said Pacific Garbage Removal Company shall receive from the City of Milwaukee for such service a sum of Ten dollars (\$10.00) per month as long as the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukee remain the same as they now are. If the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukee be increased, the said Pacific Garbage Removal Company is to receive additional compensation for the removal service above described from the annexed area on a basis to be determined by this Council and said Pacific Garbage Removal Company.

Section 3. That the said Pacific Garbage Removal Company shall, at its own expense, maintain a suitable place to dispose of all garbage collected under this franchise and said company shall at all times keep the same in a sanitary condition.

Section 4. That the said Pacific Garbage Removal Company shall, at its own expense, maintain its equipment employed in the work covered by this franchise in a sanitary condition at all times and shall paint its truck or vehicle so employed at least once yearly.

Section 5. That the said Pacific Garbage Removal Company shall maintain a telephone with an attendant during regular business hours.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
