

ORDINANCE NO. 317.

An Ordinance regulating the keeping of hogs in pens within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep any hog or hogs inclosed within a pen or pens in the Town of Milwaukie located nearer than two hundred feet of any residence without first obtaining a permit from the Council to do so. If the Council shall deem it against the public health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Milwaukie it may refuse to grant such permit.

In all cases the person, firm or corporation maintaining such hog pen or pens shall keep the same in a clean and sanitary condition.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine not exceeding the sum of \$100.00, or to imprisonment not exceeding 30 days.
