

1 Section 7. That Ordinance No. 50 entitled "An Ordinance licensing,
2 taxing and regulating billiard halls and public places where games of billiard
3 and pool are played in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and regulating the
4 manner of issuing licenses" be, and the same is hereby, repealed.

5 Section 8. That Ordinance No. 108 entitled "An Ordinance granting
6 to L. H. Campbell, his heirs and assigns, the franchise and right to lay,
7 construct and maintain railway tracks and to operate cars thereover and to
8 transport passengers, freight, mail, baggage and express thereon, and to
9 erect, construct, maintain and operate power telephone and telegraph lines
10 in the Town of Milwaukie, County of Clackamas, State of Oregon" be and the
11 same is hereby repealed.

12 Section 9. That Ordinance No. 109 entitled "An Ordinance providing
13 for the improvement of Laurel Avenue in Milwaukie, Oregon, from Cleveland
14 Street westward to Railroad Avenue, and declaring an emergency" be and the
15 same is hereby repealed.

16 Section 10. That Ordinance No. 150 entitled "An Ordinance granting
17 to the Portland & Oregon City Railway Company, its successors and assigns,
18 the right, privilege and franchise to lay, construct and maintain railway
19 tracks, and appurtenances thereto, and to operate cars thereover, and to
20 transport passengers, freight, mail, baggage and express thereon, and to
21 erect, construct, and maintain poles, wires, and underground conduits in
22 the Town of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon" be and the same is hereby
23 repealed.

24 Section 11. That Ordinance No. 151 entitled "An Ordinance regulat-
25 ing public dance halls and places where dancing is engaged in, and providing
26 a penalty for the violation of the provisions hereof" be and the same is
27 hereby repealed.

28 Section 12. That Ordinance No. 153 entitled "An Ordinance
29 regulating the sale and discharge of firecrackers and fire works within
30 the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith
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1 and providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance"
2 be and the same is hereby repealed.
